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#### **Abstract**

It is said to be a science because according to Luther Gulick management is seen as a field of knowledge that systematically seeks to understand why and how people work together. One aspect that should receive the main attention of every educational administrator is regarding educational facilities and infrastructure. Educational facilities generally include all levels and equipment that are directly used and support the educational process, such as: Buildings, study/classrooms, learning tools/media, tables, chairs and so on. While what is meant by infrastructure are facilities that indirectly support the

course of the educational process, such as: courtyards, gardens/school gardens, roads leading to schools (Kuning, 2021).

The management of school facilities and infrastructure is a part of the study in school education administration, or education administration and at the same time is the area of work of the school principal as the school administrator. As a part of the education administration study, it is reviewed from the point of view of how to provide professional services in the field of facilities and infrastructure or work facilities for school personnel. With effective and efficient management it is expected to increase the effectiveness and work efficiency of school personnel (Sartipa, 2021). Educational facilities and infrastructure are an important component in education and become one of the eight National Education standards. So the importance of educational infrastructure so that every institution competes to meet the standards of educational facilities and infrastructure in order to improve the quality of the learning process is not only that, the completeness of infrastructure Education is one of the attractions for prospective students (Barnawi & Arifin, 2012).

Management is the process of working together between individuals and groups as well as other resources in achieving organizational goals as a management activity (Silalahi, 2002). Theory, practice, and educational research cite a number of sources regarding the term management. Management also comes from Latin, namely from the origin of the word manus which means hand and agete which means to do. The words are combined into the verb managere which means to handle. Managere is translated into English in the form of work to manage, with the noun management, and manager for people who carry out management activities. Finally management is translated into Indonesian into management or management. according to a book entitled management. In relation to the implementation of facilities and infrastructure, the availability of facilities and infrastructure is one of the important components that must be met in supporting the education system. Facilities and infrastructure management education can be interpreted as the entire process of procurement and Utilization of components directly or indirectly supports educational process to achieve educational goals effectively and efficient (Hartoni, 2018).

Discussions about facilities and infrastructure in the world of education in Indonesia are always at the same time as efforts to improve the quality of education, the quality of education itself. Therefore, in article 45 paragraph 1 of the Law on the National EducationSystem it is explained. Every formal and non-formal education unit provides facilities and infrastructure that meet the needs in accordance with the growth and development of the physical, intellectual, social, emotional and psychological potential of students (Kompri, 2012). Education is a continuous process that must continue along with human age. Quality and certain quality education will produce human resources that can optimize the potential of other resources in the country. As dr. Kartini Kartono stated that the key to future development is education. (Aprijon, 2014). In the Management process, the main functions performed by a manager/leader are involved, namely planning, organizing, leading, and controlling. Therefore, management is defined as the process of planning, organizing, leading and controlling organizational efforts in all its aspects so that organizational goals are achieved effectively and efficiently.

Management of school facilities and infrastructure is one part of studies in school education administration, or education administration and as well as being the field of work of the principal as a school administrator. As one part of the educational administration study in terms of how to provide services professionally in the field of facilities and equipment infrastructure or work facilities for school personnel. Management of educational facilities and infrastructure is tasked with regulating and maintaining infrastructure so that they can contribute optimally and meaningfully to the course of the educational process. These management activities include planning, procurement, monitoring, inventory storage, and elimination and structuring activities. Good management of infrastructure is expected to create a clean, neat, and beautiful schoolso

as to create pleasant conditions for both teachers and students to be in school (Mulyasa, 2004).

Educational facilities are one of the determining factors for the success of education. The completeness and availability of educational facilities in schools greatly affects the effectiveness and smoothness of learning in the classroom. In simple terms, schoolsupplies management can be defined as a collaborative process to utilize all educational equipment effectively and efficiently. Based on this simple definition, in essence the management of educational facilities and infrastructure in schools is a process of utilizing all facilities and infrastructure owned by schools. All school facilities or infrastructure must be managed properly so that the existence of these facilities and infrastructure can support the learning process and be used in accordance needs, so that classroom learning can run smoothly and educational goals can be realized (Sinta, 2019). Management facilities and infrastructure are activities that arrange to prepare everything equipment/material for the implementation of the process education at school (Rohiat & Pd, 2010). Facilities management and infrastructure needed to help smooth teaching and learning process. Management facilities and infrastructure can be interpreted as organizing activities, starting from planning requirements, procurement, storage and distribution, utilization, maintenance, inventory and deletion as well arrangement of land, buildings, equipment, and school furniture as well as appropriate and appropriate target (Sobri, 2009).

Management of educational facilities and infrastructure as a comprehensive activity starting from planning, procurement, use, maintenance, and write-off of various educational properties owned by an educational institution (Hairul, 2017). Management is the activity of a person in managing organizations, institutions that are both human and non-human, so that the goals of the organization, institution or school can be achieved effectively and efficiently (Novi & Etikariena, 2022). Students and teachers are used as reasons why these facilities and infrastructure need to be provided, besides being used as inhibiting factors, they can also be used as supporting factors so that these facilities and infrastructure can be provided (Prastyawan, 2016). The process of management of educational facilities and infrastructure must be carried out effectively and professionally by referring to existing minimum principles and standards (Hermino, 2014). The main objective in the determination to meet the needs of the learning process in the classroom. Thus the procurement of educational facilities and infrastructure is carried out by school leaders based on a mutual agreement and by looking at the needs of the school. The second procurement of educational facilities and infrastructure is the source of procurement, the source of procurement through the repair of damaged goods, the purchase of new goods using funds from the government and community donations, borrowing from the private sector and exchanging new goods for damaged goods. These findings are supported by findings Gronberg, Jansen, and Taylor (2011), which essentially state that in terms of procurement of educational facilities and infrastructure, funds are used from the government and private parties that are directly related to educational institutions.

The findings above are in line with the theory expressed by Benty and Gunawan (2017), which essentially reveal that sources of procurement of facilities and infrastructure can be through purchasing, self-manufacturing, receiving grants or loans from private parties, leasing, and loans from institutions related to schools. The first maintenance of educational facilities and infrastructure is the daily maintenance carried out by each teacher and all students, maintenance carried out such as cleaning the classroom, storing learning tools after use, and maintaining textbooks. This is supported by Gonzales, Kuuskropi, Kaarina, and Finland (2011), in essence stating that with daily maintenance, educational facilities and infrastructure can be well maintained and able to support the learning process. The implementation of education will not be successful without the support of educational facilities and infrastructure needed in the world of education. So madrasas have facilities and infrastructure that support the success of the teaching and learning process (Khaerudin, 2007). Management of educational facilities and infrastructure is in charge of regulating and maintain educational facilities and infrastructure so that they can contribute optimally and meaningfully in the course of the educational process. Activity This management includes planning, procurement, supervision, inventory storage, and deletion and arrangement. Facility management and good

infrastructure is expected to create a clean school, neat, and beautiful so as to create favorable conditions for both teachers and students to be in school.
